KARL'S SERVICE TIP:

Tires: Tires on campers can be a real problem. The biggest reason for failure is due to improper tire pressure and overloaded vehicles. Most tires lose air over time. Tires can lose air suddenly if you drive over a pothole or other object, or if you strike the curb when parking or turning. Always inspect your tires before each trip. Locate the recommended tire pressure on the vehicle's tire. Always keep pressure at the psi recommended on the tire when the tire is cold. Cold means the tire hasn't been driven on for at least three hours. Your camper will also tow better.

Karl's Favorite Ham & Asparagus Casserole

- 1 pkg. (10 oz.) frozen cut asparagus
- 4 hard cooked eggs (peeled & chopped)
- 1 cup cubed ham
- 2 tbs. tapioca
- ¼ cup grated American cheese
- 2 tbs. chopped green pepper
- 1 tbs. chopped fresh parsley
- 1 tbs. lemon juice
- ½ cup light cream or evaporated milk
- 1 cup mushroom soup (undiluted)
- Topping
- 1 cup soft bread crumbs
- 2 tbs. butter, melted

On stove top, blanch asparagus cuts in covered dish for 3 minutes; drain thoroughly. In a 2-1/2 quart baking dish, combine asparagus, eggs & ham. Sprinkle tapioca evenly over all. Add cheese, green pepper, onion & parsley mix gently. In a small bowl, blend the lemon juice, cream & soup; add to casserole & mix thoroughly. Mix topping ingredients & sprinkle over top of casserole. Bake at 375 ° for 25-30 minutes. Let stand a few minutes before serving.

ALERT--In case anyone is considering doing some camping this spring or summer, please note the following public service announcement: In Alaska, tourists are warned to wear tiny bells on their clothing when hiking in bear country. The bells warn away MOST bears. Tourists are also cautioned to watch the ground on the trail, paying particular attention to bear droppings to be alert for the presence of Grizzly Bears. One can tell a Grizzly dropping because it has tiny bells in it.
